AUTHORITIES AMS

The Åland Government's Labour Market & Study Service Office

WE OFFER: Financial support in the form of unemployment and study benefits. The basic requirement for being granted unemployment benefits is to be registered as a job seeker with us and be between 17 and 67 years of age. If you are under 25 years and lack education, you have an obligation to apply for a study program/ course to be entitled to unemployment benefits. Study grants are given to those who are at least 17 years of age.

HOW? You register as a job seeker on AMS's website. You apply for benefits electronically through our website, but this can also be done on site.

FPA

KELA Social Insurance Institution of Finland

WE OFFER: Financial support depending on the situation. We offer benefits such as housing benefits, daily sickness allowance, child benefits, parental allowance, maintenance allowance, rehabilitation, disability benefits, national pension, and reimbursement of medical expenses.

HOW? The application for benefits is made on FPA's website via the e-service and managed with your online banking codes. Most cases can be handled via the telephone service, you can also book an appointment or handle the cases without an appointment a few days a week.

NOTE! People living and staying in Åland cannot apply for social assistance, child home care allowance or maternity grant from FPA/Kela. Social assistance and maternity grants are managed by KST (Kommunernas socialtjänst) and the child home care allowance by your municipality. Unemployment benefits and financial aid for students are applied from AMS.

KST

The municipalities' social services

WE OFFER: Financial support for individuals or families when their incomes and assets are not sufficient for necessary daily expenses. In adult social work, you can receive financial assistance in the form of income support for e.g. basic living expenses, housing and health care expenses, household electricity, home insurance, childcare fees, acquisition of necessary ID documents and other similar expenses. Since the income support is a financial support that is applied for in the last resort, you should also apply for benefits from e.g. AMS, FPA or an unemployment insurance fund. KST offers maternity support for expectant mothers in the form of a maternity package or a tax-free lump sum of 224 euros, the opportunity to apply for reduced/waived client fees and various financial compensations to families with children such as preventive child protection or child protection initiatives. You can also apply for financial support according to the Disability Services Act, such as e.g. procurement of a car and necessary alterations, alterations to the home, appliances and machines needed to cope with the daily functions, extra costs for clothing and special diets due to your disability or illness.

HOW? Visit the KST website for further information and contact us by phone for advice and appointments. You can submit your application by using our forms or e-service.

NOTE! Home care support for parents who care for their children at home is applied for in your home municipality. Cancellation/reduction of municipal fees, e.g. childcare fees, is also applied for at the municipality.

The Åland Legal Aid and Interest Surveillance Agency

Financial and debt counselling

WE OFFER: Help to clarify your financial situation, plan your finances, and prepare suggestions for different solutions. We assist in making applications for debt restructuring at the district court, to establish a payment program at the district court and we also assist in conciliation proceedings with creditors.

HOW? You can handle matters with us by phone, by making an appointment, or by an online meeting via Skype. You can also handle matters anonymously via the website, where there is a webchat on Fridays between 10 and 12. The chat and Skype services are available to everyone in all legal aid districts, regardless of place of residence. You can also contact the financial and debt counselling service via an e-service and tell them about your situation. The financial and debt counselor responds to you as soon as possible, but no later than within a week.

THE THIRD SECTOR Diaconal work

WE OFFER: Support for people in difficulties. We provide conversational support and guidance to make your situation better and to deal with emotional stress. We can also help filling out application forms to authorities and we have a collaboration with Matbanken. In some cases, it may be possible to get limited financial assistance if an investigation shows that there is a need.

HOW? You can call or make an appointment with a diaconal worker by phone or e-mail. From the diaconal worker you can get a ticket to Matbanken.

NOTE! Turn to your own municipality's parish. To seek support from each parish, you must be a resident of the municipality you are seeking support from, however, you do not need to be a member of the church. You have access to Matbanken from all parishes.

WE OFFER: We have job training placements in cooperation with AMS. We also offer local aid in kind to those in hardship in the form of gift cards in cooperation with KST and others. We also arrange (unpaid) voluntary work in groups.

NOTE! Aid in kind is something that cannot be applied for. The social services (KST) and others assess the needs. Job training placements are primarily commissioned by AMS or the municipality of residence.

HOW? The application is sent to each club's board by e-mail. You can also send a letter, use the application form on the website (if there is one) or the current contact information on each club's Facebook-page.

NOTE! All Lions Clubs have started the project "Skoltrivsel" ("School Well-being") together. We do not have a separate website, but you can most easily apply by asking school staff such as a counselor or teacher, who will communicate the message, or through any of our clubs.
