With us at Save the Children, every child should feel safe, happy, and listened to. This means that you have the right to feel good when you're with us and to have a say in what we do together. To help you feel safe in our activities, we have five safety rules that everyone must follow.

1 No one is allowed to hurt you.



2 Everyone should be treated fairly.



3 You should always be listened to.



4 No one may take a photo of you unless you say it's okay.



5 In Save the Children's activities, children are never alone with an adult.

If someone breaks the rules or if something feels uncomfortable, you should tell an adult you trust.
